Demolition Work to Occur at the Lawrence N. Field Building During Spring Break

Dear Faculty and Staff,

As renovations continue in Baruch College's Lawrence N. Field Building at 17 Lexington Avenue (17 Lex), demolition work to modernize the building and ensure ADA compliance will occur during Spring Break, from **Friday, Mar. 30 to Sunday, Apr. 8**.

Elevators will still be operational during this time, and the building will remain functional. The lobby, as well as the southwest corner of the 3rd floor, in particular, will have intermittent periods of intense noise.

The demolition work is part of [Phase 1A](#) of ongoing renovations to transform 17 Lex into a state-of-the-art, energy-efficient, and ADA-compliant building. The upcoming work will consist of the following:

- In the building's entrance, a concrete floor slab will be removed to lower the lobby for the new ADA-compliant entrance.
- On the southwest corner of the 3rd floor, the corridor stairs will be removed and the floor of two classrooms, as well as an office, will be lowered to make those spaces ADA accessible.

All of the demolition work will be done on day shifts, and the contractors have been mandated by CUNY's Central Office to accomplish as much of the work possible during this time period. While this may be temporarily disruptive for those in the vicinity during Spring Break, it was determined that this period will be the lowest occupancy of the building until the summer.

Thank you for your patience during renovations. We will keep you updated as work and information progress.
